

Hanson Wins Award for Loan Recovery

WILLIAMSON — Roy Hanson, a biologist at the Vermont Center for Executive (VCE) who spearheaded the recovery of the Vermont State Fish and Wildlife Fund's (VFWF) loan recovery program, was awarded the 2012 Vermont Environmental Award for his work.

Hanson's efforts over the past 12 years have resulted in the recovery of over \$1 million in loan recovery. The VFWF is a non-profit organization that provides environmental services to Vermont's municipalities and is a 501(c)(3) organization. It is the state's largest environmental organization.

"Roy's remarkable dedication, leadership and commitment to environmental recovery is leading the way for other organizations in Vermont," said VCE Executive Director, Steve Williamson. "Hanson's work is a shining example of what can be accomplished through the power of a dedicated and motivated team."

Hanson, leader of VCE's Vermont Loan Recovery Program, has been recognized by the Department of Fish and Wildlife, co-recipient of the award.
